Students Satisfaction Survey Report 2021-2022

.

During the academic year 2021-2022, the college undertook online students satisfaction survey. For this purpose, online link was sent to students on 20/07/2022 and feedback report was collected on 22/08/2022. In this survey 263 students were participated from various departments in the college. A feedback questionnaire devised by IQAC consisting of seventeen questions was circulated online and the students responded to it with great enthusiasm.

The questions asked in the feedback elicited response of the students on different aspects of college functioning such as the admission process, college time table, seating arrangement, use of I.C.T. for teaching, laboratories, workshops, text books, reference books, news papers, transaction of library text books, use of library e-sources, clean surroundings, provision of drinking water, playground inside the campus, sport equipment, quality of food items in college canteen, college washroom facility, curricular and co-curricular activities held in college discipline in college campus and lastly suggestions of students were taken

It is observed through the survey that 97.7% of the students are satisfied about admission process whereas only 2.3% of the students were not satisfied with it. Regarding the college time table 95.8% students are satisfied and 4.2% are not satisfied. 92% of the students are satisfied with the seating arrangement of the classroom while 8% students are unsatisfied. An around 91.3% students are found satisfactory with the use of I.C.T. for teaching whereas 8.7% of the students are not satisfied. It is found that 95.4% of the students are satisfied with well-equiped laboratories and only 4.6% of them are unsatisfied. About 92.8% of the students are satisfied with provision of text book, reference books, magazines and newspapers while 7.2% of students are not satisfied. It is also observed that 93.2% of the students are satisfied with the co-operation of the library attendant during the transaction of books whereas 6.8% of the students are not satisfied. Around 80.6% of the students are satisfied and also use e-sources of the library and about 19.4% are unsatisfied. Regarding the availability of sufficient pure drinking water 89.7% shows satisfaction whereas 10.3% shows dissatisfaction about the quality of food items of the college canteen around 82.5% of the students are satisfied while 17.5% are not satisfied with it. Regarding the availability of sufficient washroom facilities 84% shows satisfaction whereas 16% shows dissatisfaction. Regarding the playground facility in the college campus and sufficient availability of sports equipment 92.4% are satisfied whereas 7.6% of them are unsatisfied. 97.7% of students are satisfied about the college parking and 2.3% of them are unsatisfied. For the overall development of students the college runs various curricular and co-curricular activities which 96.6% of students are satisfied with it 3.4% are not satisfied with it. Regarding the college discipline 96.2% of the students are satisfied and 3.8% are not satisfied. In this way we get all yes of no response from participated students.

From the above observation some of the students have given below feedback; it can be concluded that some of the students have opinion that there should be necessary to close lockdown and start offline college lectures regularly, to improve the quality of food item in the college canteen, also there should be sufficient washroom facilities in the college, the classroom must be kept clean, to develop e-learning sources, conduct offline exams, provide regular drinking water, according to Bio-tech students there should

be a separate laboratory for tissue culture and must be provided with white acrylic board, college uniform of the students, clean toilet, clean classroom, provide permanent wifi and internet connection, more discipline maintained in library, as well as there must be restrictions on the entry of outsiders in the college campus, etc. In this way student satisfaction survey report is given in this year.
